History of Cedar Rapids and Eastern Iowa Car Culture, Street and Racing

What do you do when you work with four other guys that all share your same passion? You form a club. And that is exactly what a group of Rockwell Radio Company employees did when they formed the Cedar Rapids Corvette Club (CRCC) in the fall of 1962.

In early 1963 the Cedar Rapids Corvette Club was incorporated and they designed the club logo. By the summer of 1963 the membership had grown from the original 5 to 30 members. In 1965 the club joined the West Region of the National Council of Corvette Clubs. The West Region consists of Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Missouri.

In 1963, 1964 and 1965 the club members all attended the Indianapolis 500 as a group. The first official Club event was a Gymkhana held in July 1963 on a Collins Radio parking lot. It was a very successful event with 90 entries.

The Club also provided race cars for the Cedar Valley Stock Car Racing Association on Saturday nights at Hawkeye Downs. And because of their long ongoing support of the racetrack, the CRCC were inducted into the Hawkeye Downs Wall of Fame in 2013.

The club has supported many charities over the years. They have donated money raised through their sponsoring or participating in car shows, rallies, and parades.

Originally the CRCC club meetings were held in member's garages but now it is held at Pat McGrath's Chevyland. From their humble beginnings of five founding members in 1962 to the current club with 150+ members, the Cedar Rapids Corvette Club has been going strong and continues to drive into the future.
